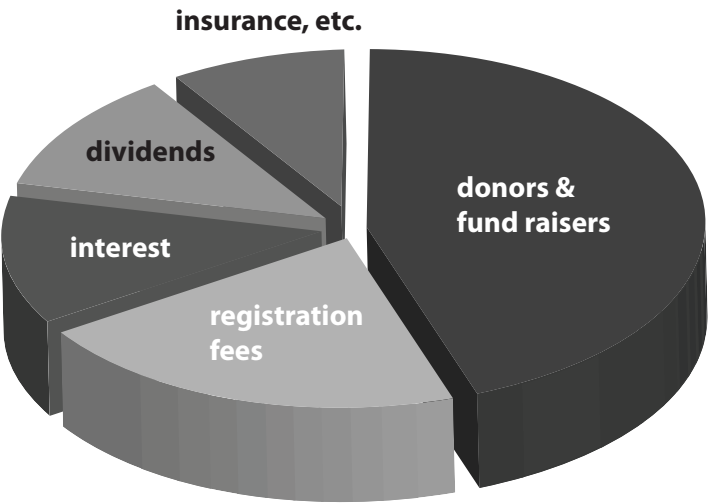

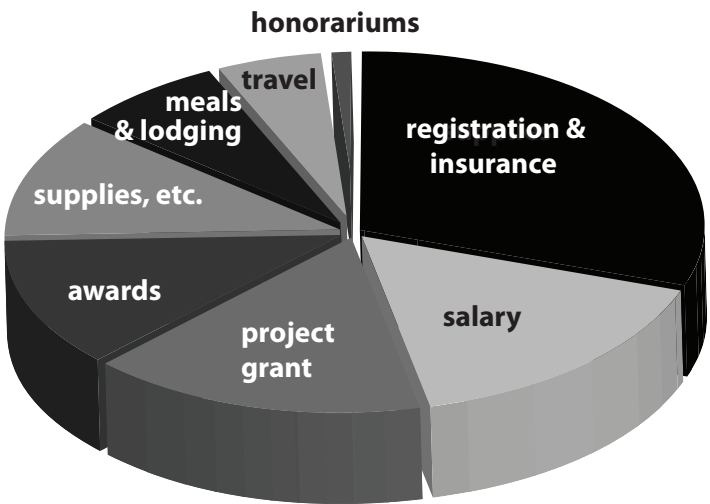

This focus will be used in all 4-H projects and allow 4-H youths a deeper understanding of the projects they are completing. Another very exciting opportunity new for this year will be the 4-H Showcase Showdown. This event will bring 4-H youths from across Wyoming to compete in horse judging, vegetable judging, presentations, workforce preparation, dog quiz bowl, and a 4-H rocket launch. Many of these events are new to Wyoming 4-H and are generating great excitement.

Donors and their generosity are the driving force behind the 4-H program in Wyoming. Without the resources donated to the Wyoming State 4-H Foundation, 4-H youths would be unable to take advantage of many of these statewide activities. Thank you to the many donors who have given.
