


Wyoming State 4-H Foundation ANNUAL REPORT 2009





Dear friends in 4-H youth development,

I am pleased to present the 2009 Wyoming State 4-H Foundation Annual Report. The Wyoming State 4-H Foundation experienced another productive year despite the downturn in the economy. This is in large part do to the commitment of the many generous donors that see the value 4-H provides the youth of Wyoming. On behalf of the nearly 9,000 4-H youth located in the 23 counties I would like to extend a thank you to each of you.

The Wyoming State 4-H Foundation held four fundraising events state-wide. The Boulder Big Draw 3D archery shoot held in Boulder. The Platte River Shootout sporting clays event held on the Silver Spur Ranch in Saratoga. Jake Clark's Mule Days held in Powell, raised funds for a 4-H scholarship. The last fundraiser was a 4-H Roper shirt sale across the state with a portion of the proceeds staying with the local county program.

Additionally, the Wyoming 4-H program continued its partnership with The Daniel's Fund. This partnership provided support of educational programming to youth on preparing to enter the workforce. Youth developed skills to succeed, mentored and explored with existing businesses, and even had the opportunity to compete for their own business start up funds. The Business Ventures contest held in June had youth from across Wyoming; they presented their own business plans in an interview setting. The youth were awarded nearly \$10,000 in support of their entrepreneurial businesses.

Donors and their generosity are the driving force behind the 4-H program in Wyoming. Without the resources donated to the Wyoming State 4-H Foundation, the 4-H youth would be unable to take advantage of numerous statewide activities. Again, thank you to the many donors who have supported the 4-H program and its youth. 



TOP EIGHT 4-H PROJECTS




2008-2009 4-H ENROLLMENT




