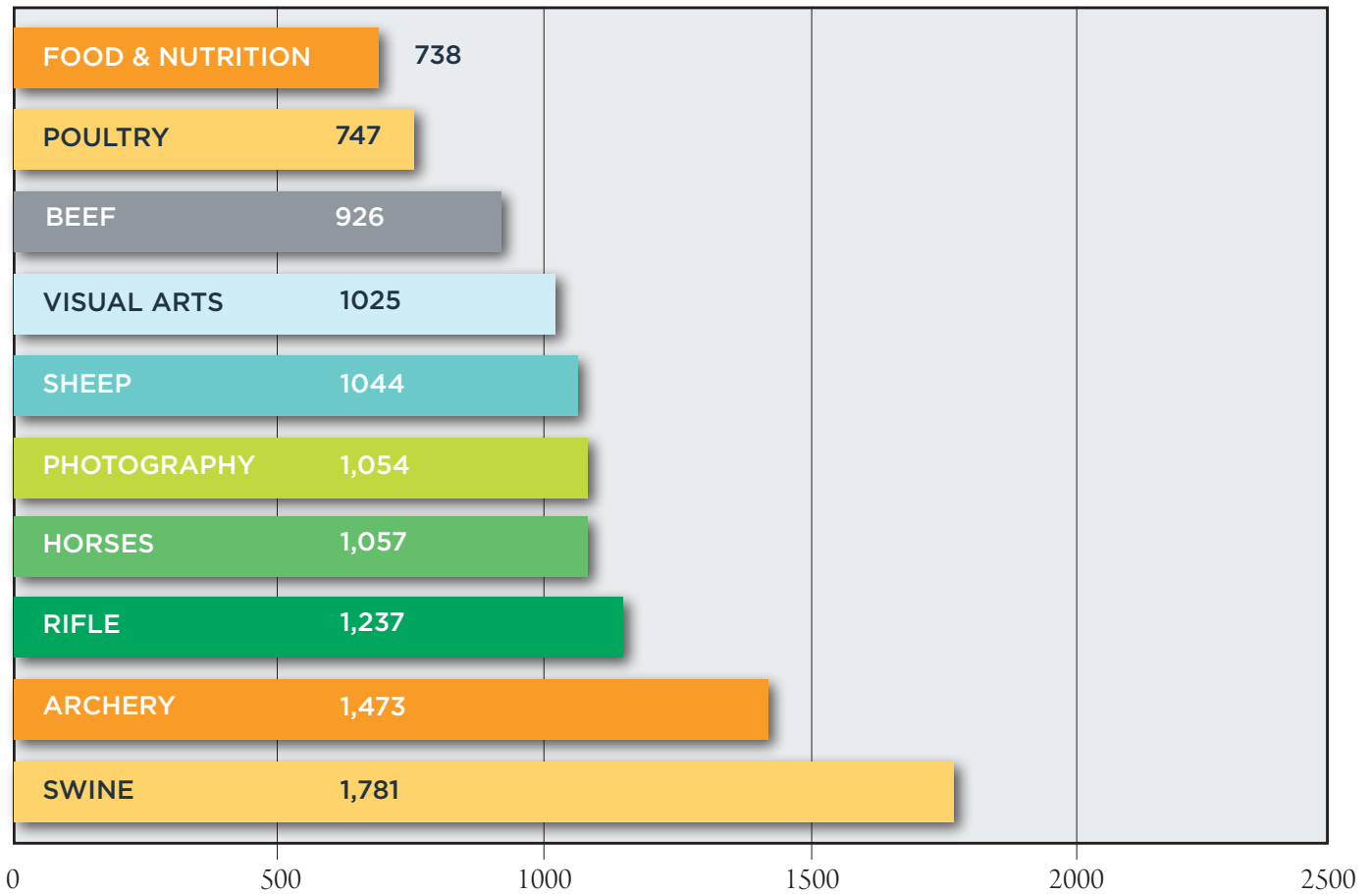

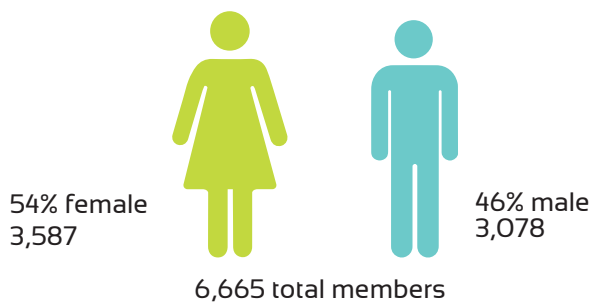

TOP 4-H PROJECT ENROLLMENTS



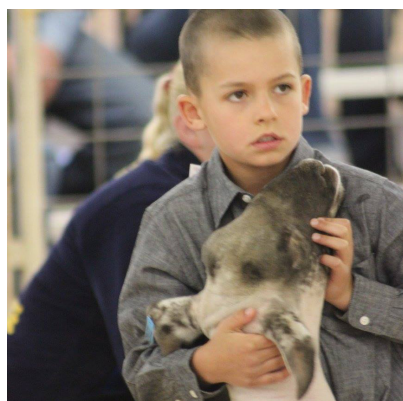
2017-2018 4-H ENROLLMENT

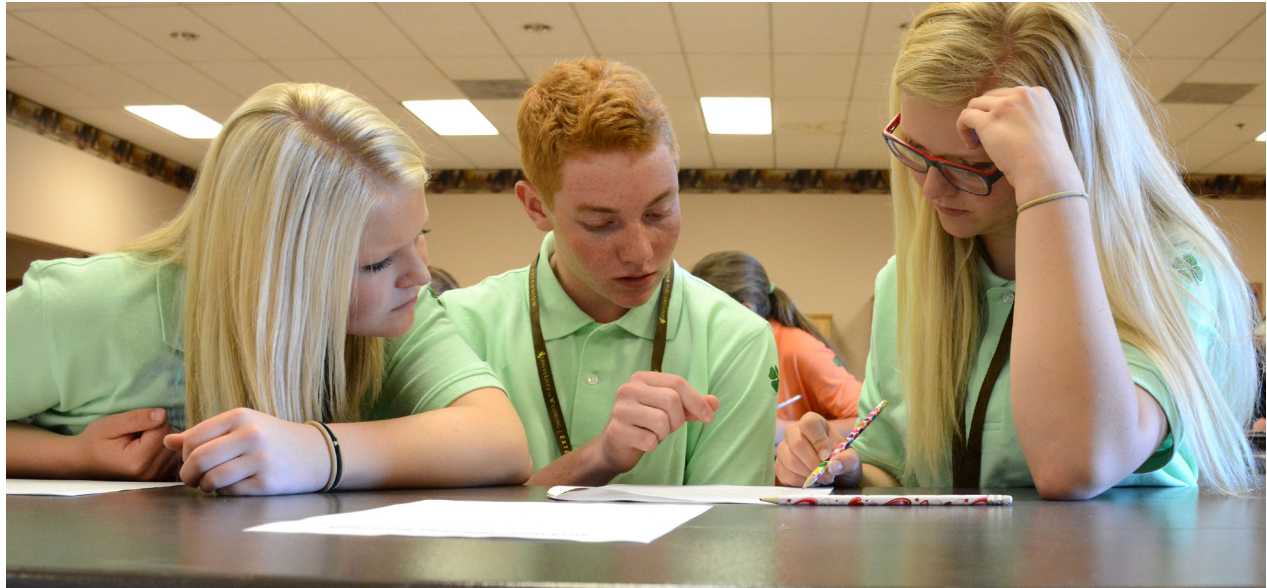

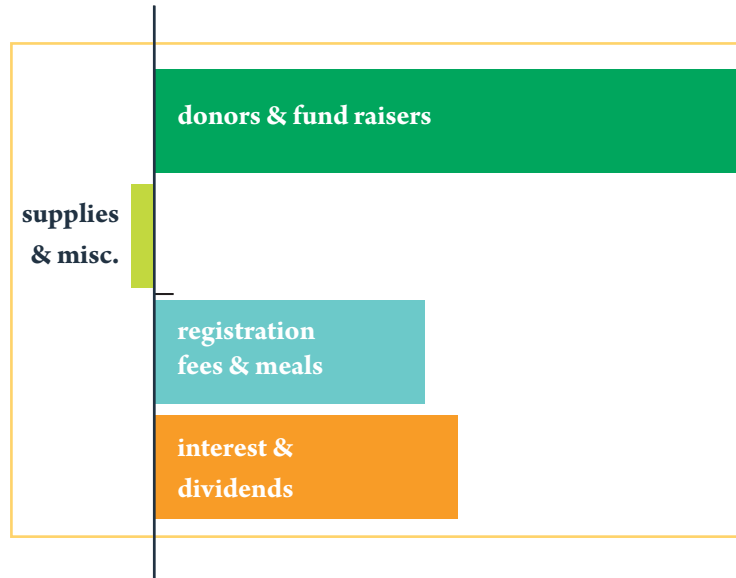

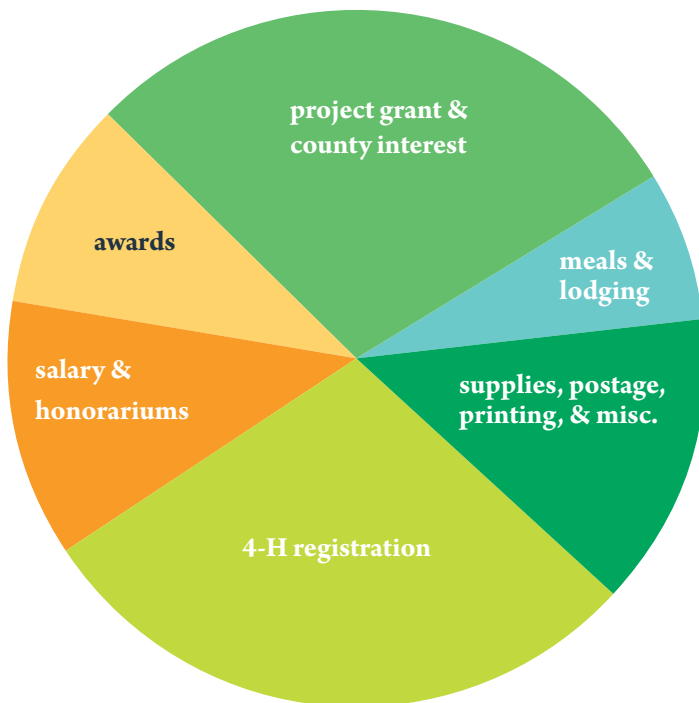
