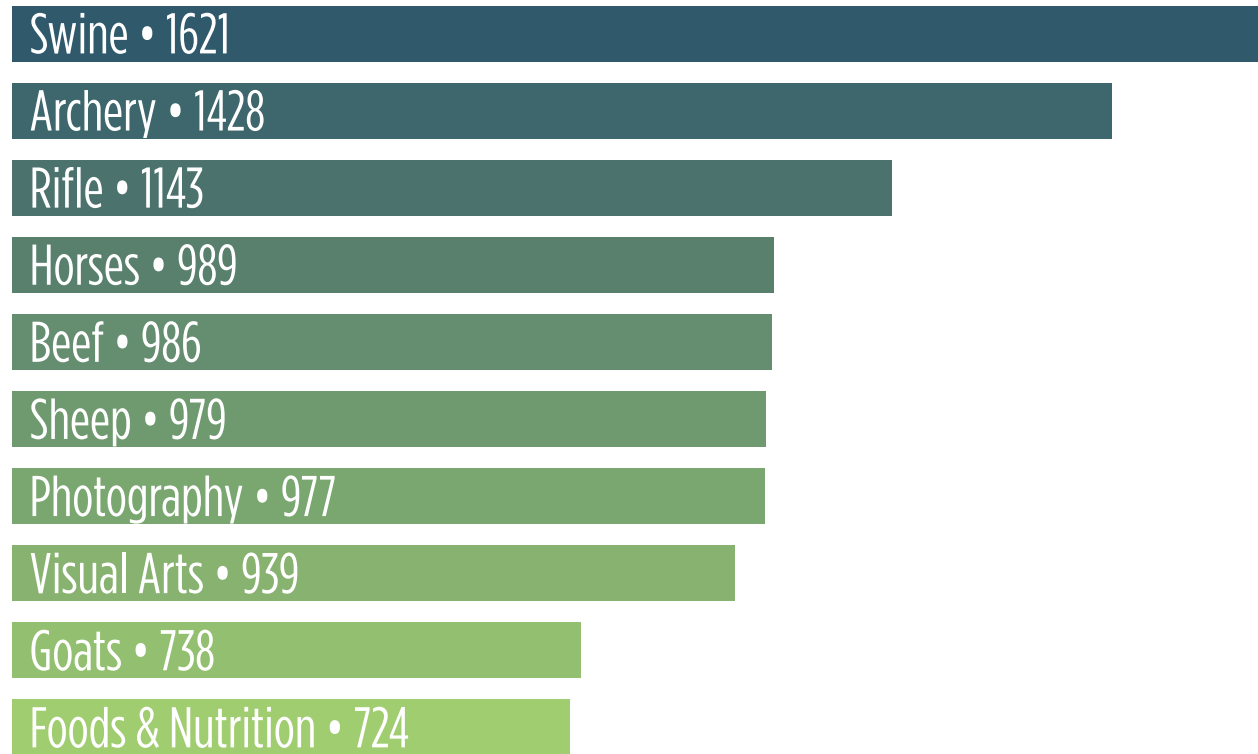

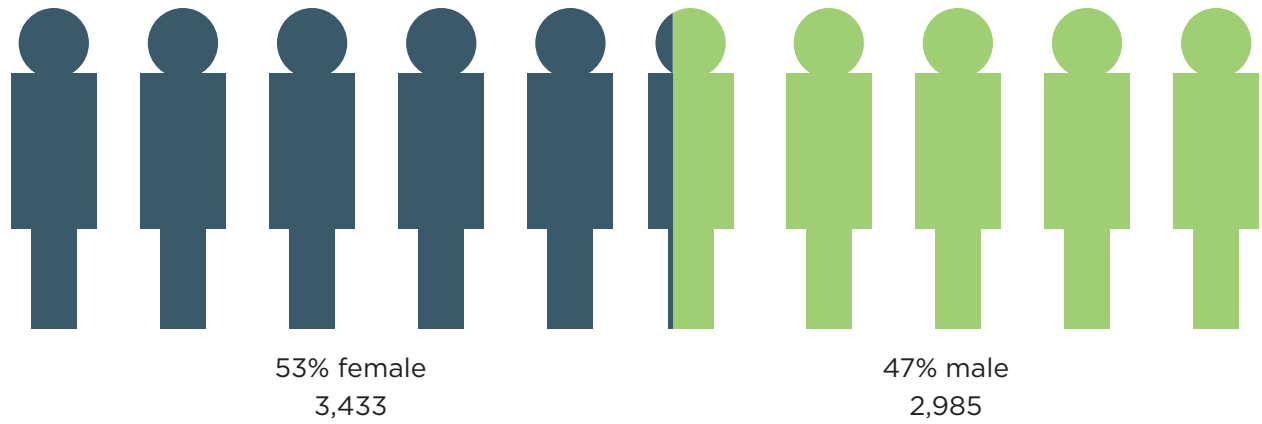


Top 4-H project enrollments

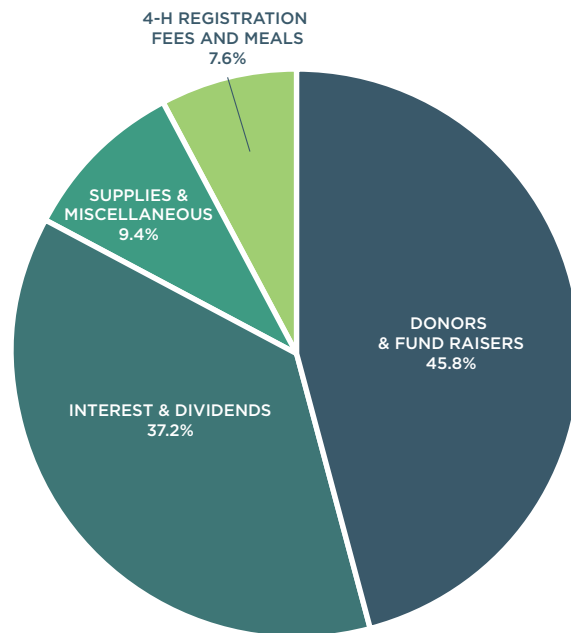

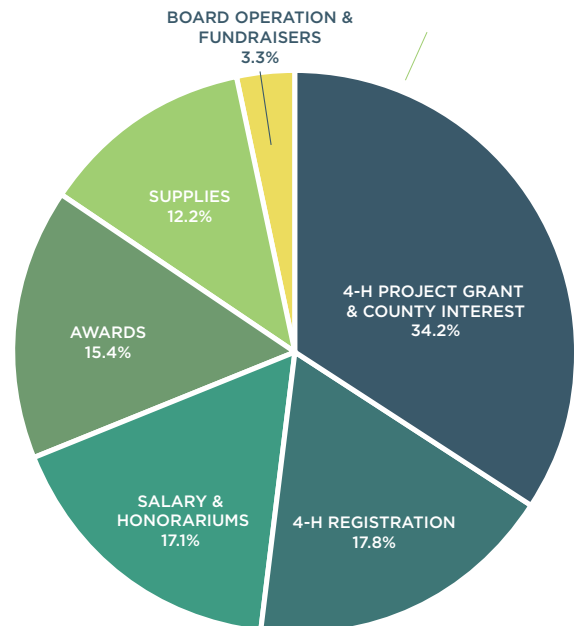
