

Jared Sare Memorial 4-H Scholarship 2022 Application – Continuing Education

The Jared Sare Memorial Fund has made a commitment to provide scholarships to Sublette County 4-H youth in remembrance of Jared Sare, former local veterinarian and Sublette County resident. Money raised through the Jared Sare Memorial Ranch Rodeo goes to the local 4-H program with an interest in agriculture and participating in their local community. The number and financial amounts of the scholarships vary from year-to-year depending on the funds raised and number of applicants.

The following are eligibility requirements for the Continuing Education Scholarship:

1. Must be a currently active Sublette County 4-H member.
2. Must be a graduating senior residing in either Sublette County School District #1 or #9 (including homeschool students).
3. Applicant must complete senior 4-H year to remain eligible.
4. Applicant must plan to attend a college, technical or vocational school or certification in a trade and use the funds to continue their education.

To apply for the scholarship, please provide all of the following documents to the Extension Office (physically handed in or by mail - PO Box 579, Pinedale, WY 82941) no later than January 5, 2022. Please note that failure to provide all of the documents below immediately disqualifies the application. Successful applicants will be recognized and receive scholarship funds at the Jared Sare Western Social on January 29, 2022.

1. This form with applicant information completed
2. Essay/story addressing the topic “How would you use the scholarships funds to continue your education?”
3. Document with school or training program dates of entry for certification or degree
4. Resume
5. Current high school transcripts
6. Two letters of recommendation with one being from a 4-H volunteer leader, not to include Extension personnel.
