

Here is a simple community service project you can do at your next 4-H Club Meeting.

SERVICE PROJECT

UNIVERSITY WYOMING EXTENSION : 333 €

Supplies Needed: -comic strip template -fine tip sharpie markers -candy bar

-ink pads -blank paper and pencil -scotch tape



Instructions:

- You will be creating a finger print cartoon strip.

- Finger print cartoon characters are created by taking your finger and placing it on an ink pad and then transferring it to a piece of paper. Depending on how large you want your cartoon determines which finger you should use. The easiest way to transfer the finger print is place the side of our finger on the ink pad and roll your finger until the tip is covered in ink.

-On blank piece of paper practice creating your cartoon character and create the message for your comic strip "what will be included in each box"

-Once you have a rough draft created, **complete the comic strip template that is on the attached page.**

-Roll the completed comic strip template around 4.2\4.4oz. large candy bar and give to a special person or family that is currently or has served in the military thanking them for their service.
