





CHANGES FOR FAIR 2022

The only exception is if there is a family emergency. Please note, the exhibitor does not have to be present but their animal must be or they will not be eligible to show at fair.

TAGGING DATES:


Tuesday, May 31st at the Extension Office starting at 5pm

Swine breed classes will be added to this year's fair.

- There must be a minimum of 5 animals to have a class.
- The swine show will be classified by breed, then weight within each breed division.
- A classification committee of 3 will classify swine breeds at tagging by visual appraisal as outlined in the attached guidelines.



Deadline March 1st

The Sublette County 4-H Foundation has made a commitment to provide so in each of the county's school districts. Scholarship(s) will be awarded in Districts. Number and amounts to be determined, based on funds and catio

The following are eligibility requirements for the 4-H Foundation Smolarship:

- Must be a graduating senior residing in either Sublette County School D t #1 or #9 (cluding homeschool students).
- 2. Must be a currently active 4-H member.
- 3. Applicant must complete senior 4-H year (including turning in a Record Book by the due date) to remain eligible.
- Must earn a 2.0 GPA (or passing status) or higher during first semester of full-time enrollment (12+ credit hours) of higher education and be enrolled in a full-time second semester to retain eligibility.
- 5. Successful applicants must provide first semester college, technical or vocational school transcripts documenting full-time enrollment and at least a 2.0 (or passing status) GPA along with proof of full-time enrollment (12+ credits) for the second semester of higher education no later than February 1st of their first year of school.
- 4-H Foundation scholarships can begin to be used no later than two academic years after high school graduation. Exceptions may be made for extended military service or religious sojourns.

To apply for the scholarship, please provide <u>ALL</u> of the following documents to the Extension Office no later than **March 1, 2022**. Please note that failure to provide all of the documents below immediately disqualifies the application.

- Letter of Application (cover letter) addressing the topic, "How 4-H has Prepared Me for the Future"
- 2. Resume that includes community service, work, and leadership experience
- Two letters of recommendation with one being from a 4-H volunteer leader, not to include Extension personnel.
- 4. Current high school transcripts
- 5. 4-H Record Book/Portfolio This is a compilation of All Sections of your time and years in 4-H. Example: Each year's projects and then cumulative service and leadership, etc.

If you are eligible, we invite you to apply. Please mail or hand in the application materials directly to the Extension Office by March 1st. Please do not hesitate to contact the Extension Office if you have any questions regarding the scholarship or application materials at 307-367-4380.

You may also find other scholarship opportunities from the Wyoming State 4-H Foundation by visiting www.wyomina4h.ora/4hfoundation/scholarships/. Please note, these scholarships require a different application.
