

### A NOTE FROM THE EDUCATOR


I can hardly believe it is already May! I'm looking forward to the warmer weather coming in the next couple of weeks and hoping it will be a long time before we see snow again!

If you are delivering a thank you basket or another gift item, be sure to take a picture during delivery and submit it as proof)
Submit 4-H Record Book with completed Involvement Report and Project Record for your market animal project by September 30, 2023. (If you would like your record book to be eligible for judging and achievement awards, it must be submitted by
September 15 <sup>th</sup> )






