




ZSuite 4-H Enrollment

Existing Family Profile

Enrollment must be done **ANNUALLY** to stay *active* in 4-H!

Go to https://4h.zsuite.org/

- 1. Use the same email & password you used to sign up, select LOGIN
- 2. Choose the PRIMARY ACCOUNT to enroll 4-H Members
- 3. You will see a list of the household members & their current enrollment status.
 - a. Red = INACTIVE 4-H Member b. Green = ACTIVE 4-H Member
- 4. Select the 4-H Member's Name you wish to update, select ENROLL MEMBER NOW
- 5. IF YOU DO NOT SEE A NAME LISTED, You will need to ADD A HOUSEHOLD MEMBER



GROWING-WY INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The overall goal of Growing Beginning Farmers and Ranchers in Wyoming is to provide education, mentoring, and technical assistance to offer beginning farmers and ranchers the knowledge, skills, and tools needed to make informed decisions for their operations, and enhance their sustainability.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 18+ years of age
- Fewer than 10 years of agricultural ownership
- Submit weekly summaries including photos/videos
 - Attend at least one educational event

2022-2023 STATISTICS

- 19 awarded internships
- 5 returning hosts awarded internships for 2023, numerous returning host applications.
 - Participating interns came from seven states, including
 Wyoming
 - 5 accepted interns have veteran status.

YEAR TWO CHANGES

- 12 weeks to 10 weeks
- \$4,800 to \$5,000
- Used Moodle as communication & assignment tracking system
- Used zoom and online training modules to orient hosts and interns selected for 2023
- Coordinator work cell phone
- Followed a screening protocol using anonymous host and intern profiles to better inform pairing for 2023 summer internships


