4-H Member and parent/legal guardian must read, sign and turn this form into the 4-H Educator or designated Shooting Sports Leader each year to participate in Shooting Sports. The following are some guidelines for the Crook County 4-H Shooting Sports Program:

Range Guidelines:

1. Safety First and then have fun!
2. No adults on the shooting line except state certified 4-H shooting sports leaders.
3. **NO USE OF CELL PHONES OR TEXTING WHILE ON THE SHOOTING LINE DURING PRACTICE.**
4. Appropriate Attire: Closed toe shoes will be worn. Inappropriate clothing is prohibited such as short shorts, spaghetti straps, clothing promoting alcohol or tobacco, cut off shirts, low cut shirts, low waisted pants. Other items are left to the discretion of the 4-H Educator or shooting sports leaders in control of the practice.
5. **THINGS THAT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED:**
 - a. HORSEPLAY
 - b. RUNNING ON THE RANGE
 - c. WAIVING FIREARMS ABOUT AND PLAYING WITH THEM WHEN NOT ON AN ACTIVE OPEN RANGE
 - d. BULLYING OR HARRASMENT OF ANY KIND TOWARD OTHER SHOOTERS, PARENTS, LEADERS, ETC.
6. If these guidelines are not followed, the youth will be expected to remain for the full one hour during shooting and observe their teammates practice and parents will be notified of their behavior.
7. Prior to shooting, the Range Commander will give final instructions on practice for the day so everyone knows the expectations before they begin.
8. **ALL PERSONALLY OWNED EQUIPMENT WILL BE CASED WHEN BROUGHT TO PRACTICE/SHOOTING LINE!!!!**

General Information:

- 4-H members are required to be enrolled no later than April 1 of the current year to participate in county shoot.
- **4-H MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO BE SIGNED UP FOR (AND PAID FOR) THE CURRENT 4-H YEAR IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY SHOOTING SPORTS ACTIVITIES! NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

- Each 4-H member is required to pay a \$10 fee or participate in one sanctioned community service event per year.
- In order to shoot at County Shoot the members must attend a minimum of 3 practices in the discipline they are participating in at county shoot.
- **NO LATE ENTRIES** accepted for County Shoot.
- All rules from the County Fair Book shall apply.
- Crook County 4-H owns air rifles, air pistols, .22 rifles, genesis bows, and shotguns.
- All shooting sports equipment can be checked out by an active, certified shooting sports leader and used at county practices and county shoot ONLY. No 4-H member will be allowed to check out equipment and/or take it home with them.
- The certified leader must be certified in the respective discipline. The equipment will be available at each practice for shooters to borrow. **CERTIFIED SHOOTING SPORTS LEADERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE EQUIPMENT THEY CHECK OUT.**
- 4-H youth must be proficient at air before moving onto .22 caliber.
- All county equipment will be transported by the 4-H educator to the State Shoot.

Shooting Sports is a serious project area in 4-H and every 4-H member should act accordingly. Horseplay or such can cause serious damage when around shooting sports equipment.
