- 30% on overall 4-H/FFA work
- 30% on character and leadership in their clubs, and participation in their County Fair and Wyoming State Fair.

- Copy of College transcript.
- Letter of recognition from your 4-H Educator/Leader or FFA Advisor, County Fair Manager or a Fair board Member
