Responsibilities:

1. Assist the designated area superintendent in coordinating, preparing, facilitating and administering fair activities. These activities may include but are not limited to:
 - Helping clean-up, set-up and take down facilities
 - Assist during check-in and check-out and weigh-in
 - Clerking
 - Announcing
 - Running contests
 - Serving as ring/gate steward
 - Distributing ribbons and other awards
 - Hosting shows
 - Helping during exhibitor meetings
2. Attend all Youth Show Committee meetings as scheduled and required by the designated area superintendent.
3. Attend Fair Board meeting with the Youth Show Coordinator, if necessary.
4. Be available and willing to work during fair time.

Eligibility:

1. Any Senior Goshen County 4-H members or High School FFA member (candidates are not eligible to apply for a Junior Superintendent Position they will be exhibiting projects in).

Qualifications:

1. Dependability
2. Ability to effectively communicate with others
3. Ability to work as a team member
4. Ability to follow directions
5. Self-starter

Requirements:

1. Completed application
2. Availability during fair

Youth Benefits:

1. Leadership Skills
2. Team building skills
3. Communication skills
4. Role model to younger 4-H/FFA members

Fair/Superintendent Benefits:

1. Youth leaders assume important responsibilities that will assist the designated area Superintendent in performing their duties
2. Visibility of youth in leadership roles at fair
