Thank You Note & Record Book Deadline

September 30 is the deadline to submit Goshen County Fair Thank You Notes to the Extension Office by 4pm. Those who do not submit thank you notes by this deadline are not eligible for awards and prizes at the 2023 Goshen County Fair. Sale checks will not be written until all thank you notes have been received.

September 30 is also the deadline to submit your Record Book to the Extension Office by 4pm. This important step in the 4-H year is outlined later in the newsletter. To update your record book, start in ZSuite.

September 30 is the deadline to apply for the 4-H Council Scholarship. 4-H Members who graduated in *2022* are eligible to apply for this unique scholarship. Applications are available in ZSuite and from the Extension Office.

- Re-Enroll in ZSuite by visiting
 https://4h.zsuite.org
 and update your
 contact info, club info and projects. Do
 this before March 1 to avoid late fees!
 - Some clubs may have a specific enrollment deadline, check with your Club Leader!
- Set those goals for your new project and add them to your Record Book!
 Record Books are completed using the same ZSuite system.
- New and returning volunteers should complete ZSuite enrollment, too!

- February 1 is the Market Beef
 Ownership Deadline. Tagging dates
 will likely be in January. Stay tuned!

- Hunter's Safety (necessary to shoot in Bent Barrels Crooked Arrows) will be held beginning the first week of January.

Record Books should be printed and organized in a 3-ring binder. Record Books can be submitted for *competition* or *completion*.

- Competition books are eligible for county-wide judging and awards at Achievement Day.
- Completion books are submitted for being complete and do not leave the club level.

All books are used to determine Honors Club points. Youth earning 19 points (over the course of their 4-H career) are inducted into the Wyoming 4-H Honors Club.
