King Soopers Community Rewards




Step 1. Create a digital account


Step 2. Link your Card to an organization.


Selecting the organization that you wish to support is as simple as updating the King Soopers Community Rewards selection on your digital account.



Shooting Sports Orientations

It is that time of year again. Laramie County East Side Shooting Sports will be starting their Archery Orientations. All youth must attend one of the following orientations and have all their fees paid, before they will be allowed on the shooting line. Remember, East Side refers to the kids that shoot in Pine Bluffs.

Orientations for East Side Archery will take place Tuesday, March 2nd, Thursday, March 4th, and Tuesday, March 9th at 6:30 pm and 7:30 pm both nights at High West Energy Truck Bay, 6270 CR 212, Pine Bluffs. Masks are required at orientation unless you can maintain the 6 feet social distancing.

If you are signed up for archery it is mandatory that you attend one of these orientations, no matter how many years you have been shooting....you must attend orientation every year.

Parents should plan on attending as well.

Shooting Sports Information

West Side .22 Pistol

The following is a note from West Side Pistol Leader Levi Van Kirk

- When entering the building, masks are required for everyone in the hallway and outside the indoor range.
- Everyone will gather in the hallway outside the indoor range to sign in and go over anything prior to practice where we can all hear.
- Per the shooting range, masks are not required while inside the indoor range.
 They do request leaders/adults helping out wear masks while helping the kids since leaders need to get close youth to be heard and to help youth with their pistols. Also, they request shooters wear masks while they are sitting behind the line waiting for their turn to shoot.
- They will reserve up to 6 lanes for us so shooters can be more consolidated. The lanes they will reserve are going to be kind of toward the east end but the far east lane is the ADA lane and has to remain open. Also, the range would like to leave open the 2 lanes next to the ADA lane because the benches can be swung away for people to practice drawing from a holster. We will only have one of the lanes with the lower bench so I may assign that one to a shooter with shorter stature.
- Shooters will need to take turns and rotate due to the number of shooters signed up. Those who are waiting, need to wear a mask and wait in the chairs along the wall behind the line. Please wait patiently and safely. Remember when taking pistols to and from the line, they must be cased.
- The requirement is the same for 1 adult per 2 shooters so we need at least 3
- adults on the range if 6 kids are shooting. If more adults want to come in and help that's great, just please wear a mask when helping the kids.
- We have ammo available to buy for \$3.00 a box of 50. I would ask that one of the
 parents help out with distributing the ammo to people who need it so I can
 concentrate on the shooting.

West Side Archery practices have begun. Practices are on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6pm to 8pm at Archer M/K. Practices are designed for shooters to shoot for an hour at time. Shooters do not have the entire 2 hours, we want to make sure all shooters have a fair amount of time on the line to get their practice in.







Instructors: Bruce Bauman and Garrett Barton







Wool Judging

Wool Judging? Many of you may ask "What is that?" Wool Judging is one more judging opportunity offered through Wyoming 4-H that provides kids a chance to work with their friends and other 4-H youth as a team learning together. It helps kids develop decision making skills, analytical thinking and increased knowledge. In wool judging youth learn to determine grade, yields, and how to place wool fleeces. Kids do not have to be enrolled in the sheep project to participate in wool judging. It is a great introduction to a judging program, as it doesn't require oral reasons. It is one more way to learn about another part of agriculture. There has not been a wool judging program in Laramie County for quite a few years, so we are excited to bring back this opportunity.
