Step 3. Laramie County 4-H Earns

Any transactions moving forward using the Shopper's Card number associated with your digital account will be applied to the program, at no added cost to you. King Soopers donates annually to participating organizations based on your percentage of spending as it relates to the total spending associated with all participating King Soopers Community Rewards organizations.

Youth Quality Assurance

If a youth is planning on selling a market animal in the 4-H sale at the Laramie County Fair, the youth is required to take QA once in each 4-H age group they are registered in (once as a junior 8-10, once as an intermediate 11-13, and once as a senior 14-18). Ages are based on the youth's 4-H age (age as of January 1st of the 4-H year: the age the youth was on January 1, 2021). This includes both large and small market animal sellers.

All Intermediate and Senior youth who require quality assurance will be taking the online course. This course does cost \$12.00, IF this creates a hardship for a family, scholarships are available to assist with the cost. We feel that the quality of this Quality Assurance curriculum is strong and will provide youth with current information and knowledge that will help them as they raise their livestock projects. We will continue to have face-to-face Junior Quality Assurance classes. The juniors need that face-to-face interaction with other youth in their project area, as well as they get to know the Educator who is teaching the course. If a family struggles with internet at their home and they are unable to get online to complete the course, please call Brittany to schedule a time to complete the course in our office.

Please call the Extension Office to get a coupon code from Brittany. Do not pay directly to the YQCA website. It is easier to track with the coupon code. After the class, you will need to provide a copy of the certificate of completion to our office. Here is the curriculum map from YQCA. If you have any questions or concern, please call our office and we can guide you through which classes your child needs to take and answer any additional questions.

We will be tagging all sheep, goat, and swine during the 3 available taggings. You only need to bring your animals to one of the tagging events.

- May 8: 9am to 12pm (this is a good one for swine while they are still smaller)
- May 12: 5pm to 8pm
- May 25: 5pm to 7pm

All taggings will take place at Archer. Those bringing Lambs and Goats will take the first turn into the Archer Complex between the old fair office and M/K. If you are bringing Swine you will take the second turn into the Archer Complex between M/K and the Event Center. The scale house will be open if you would like to weigh your animals. Animals will be restrained for tagging if absolutely needed.

With the change of software from 4-H Online to ZSuite the animal identification requirements are different. All animal information needs to be uploaded into the link below by June 1st to comply with the June 1st ownership deadline. Click on the link below for each animal that needs to be entered. 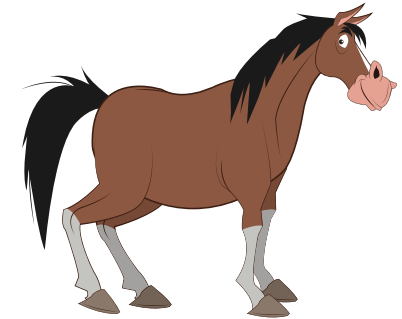
Livestock Judging Continuing
