





#### **EMERGENCY RESPONSE CERTIFICATION** THROUGH FEMA'S CERT PROGRAM

The Chevenne/Laramie County Emergency Management Agency (EMA) and the Laramie County Community Emergency Response Team are inviting all 4-H youth (ages 14+) to participate in a real world training opportunity this October (Saturday the 22nd and Saturday the 29th) to obtain their Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) certification, a program of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

PURPOSE: The CERT program trains and educates volunteers about disaster preparedness and response with skills such as light search and rescue, medical operations, fire suppression, radio communications and more. The local CERT team is a volunteer organization that professional responders can call upon to backfill essential roles during emergencies as well as during multi-agency coordinated events in our community such as parades and community charity events.



Pre-registration of the three-part training opportunity is mandatory and each portion must be successfully completed for CERT Basic certification. Please note that successful completion of the online portion is a prerequisite to attend any live-training exercise, but interested students are encouraged to complete registration for each component of the course simultaneously and without delay. Due to the hands-on nature of the in-person training exercises there will only be space for twenty students in these classes and will be awarded on a first-come first-serve basis. Additional trainings will be scheduled to meet any 4-H demand in excess of the class limit at a date to be determined later.

The State 4-H Office is offers up \$2000 in awards each year for clubs who have exceptional community service projects and learning activities, awards 10 clubs with \$200 each for their monthly activities.

How does it work?

~~ Clubs are asked to share community service work (Hands to Larger Service Award) and Learning Experiences (Head to Clearer Thinking Award) they engaged in. This work cannot be events or activities planned at the county level, but rather those that are part of a yearly Club Awards Opportunity club program.

~~Awards will be given based on community service projects that run from October 1, 2021 - September 30, 2022.
