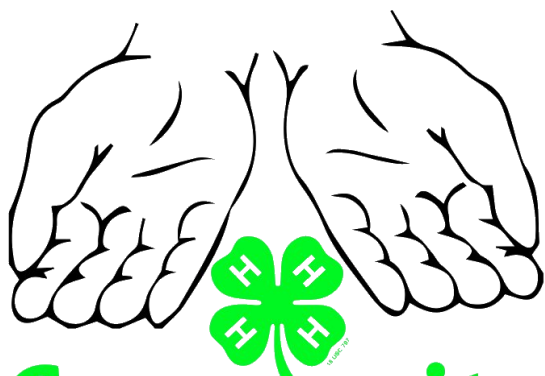
Supplies Needed:

My name is Brianna Hollingsworth, and I am from Laramie County, WY. I am a 2023 NILE Merit Heifer recipient and wanted to tell you about the NILE Merit Heifer program. This program will help you start your own herd of cattle. You fill out an application and then they will choose about 20 kids to receive a heifer. This heifer is donated to you by a beef producer. Each month you check in with the NILE program coordinator and your donor and complete a report about your heifer and the things that you are learning. You will be able to keep this heifer if you finish the program. You finish the program when you successfully breed her and show her at the NILE Stock Show in Montana that is held in October. I have really had fun this year so far with my heifer, Trixie. My donors, Kaitlin and Ean, of Quarter Circle Livestock have been a huge part in my success so far this year! I really believe everyone should try for it if you are interested in raising cattle, because it really teaches you about caring and breeding your heifer to grow your herd. So far, I've been learned about other breeds and the traits that the different breeds are known for. I also got learn about different bulls and get to choose a bull from Genex to breed my heifer to. I been around cattle my entire life, but with this program you can learn more!

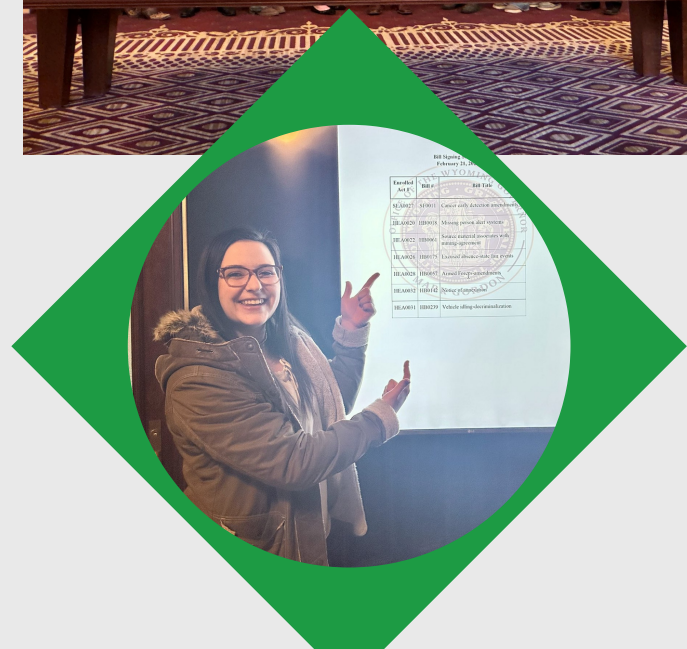

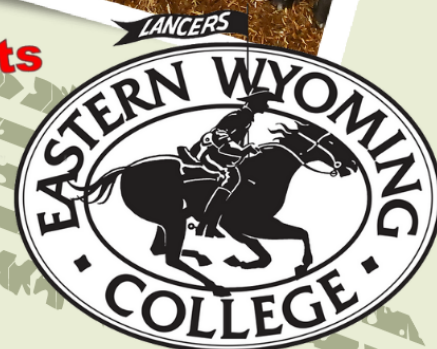

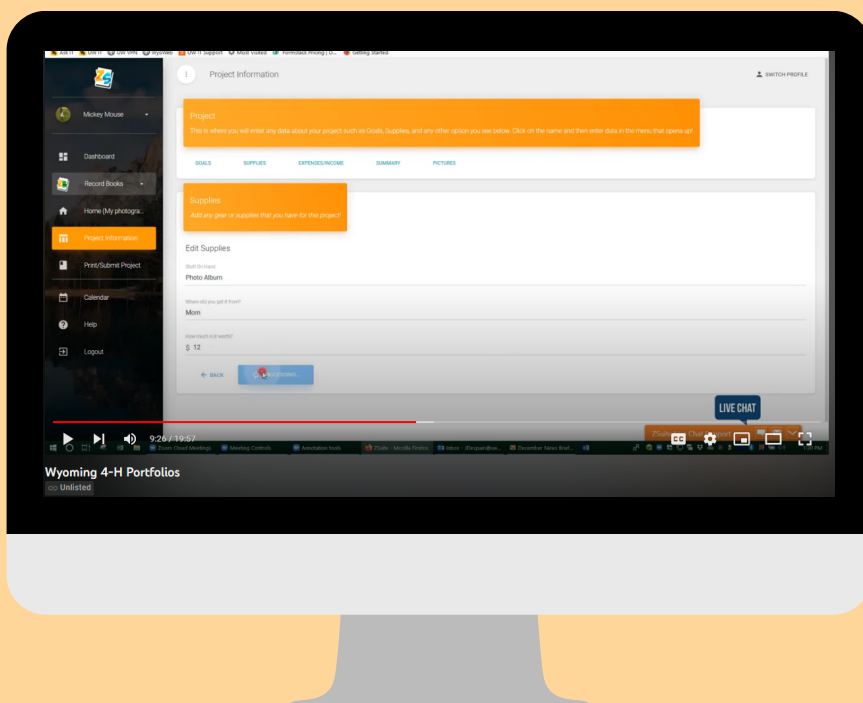
