Laramie County 4-H

What is 4-H?

4-H is the largest out of school youth organization in the United States with over 7 million youth members.

The purpose of 4-H is to help youth acquire knowledge, develop life skills, and form attitudes that will enable them to become self-directing, productive members of society.

There are Extension staff responsible for 4-H programs in every county in Wyoming. Whether you live in a city or rural area, there's something for you in 4-H.

Members learn life skills, make new friends, enhance self-esteem, achieve personal goals, develop positive relationships with peers and volunteers, and have fun learning and sharing as a family and a club.

Who can join 4-H?

Youth may be members in the traditional 4-H program in Wyoming if they have passed their 8th birthday and have not passed either 19th birthday before January 1st of the current 4-H year. A member may join at any time after October 1st, provided the member meets the age requirement (will turn 8 before January 1st and not have turned 19 by January 1st).

*Check with your clubs and projects as there may be deadlines for participation.

A 4-H Cloverbud can be between 5-7 years old by January 1st of the current 4-H year.

Wyoming and Laramie County 4-H has opportunities for adults in volunteer positions too!

What is a 4-H Project?

A topic that a member chooses to work on in a 4-H club. A 4-H project is something a member learns to do with the help of leaders and parents. Projects are open to all eligible 4-H members.

4-H projects are "learn by doing" experiences.

Youth should select a project they are interested in and would like to learn about. Don't be afraid to pick projects you don't know much about, because the whole point of a 4-H project is to learn about it. You work on the project(s) throughout the year, keep records of what you do and learn, and then you can exhibit your projects at places such as the County Fair, County Shoot, or Showcase Showdown.

4-H Clubs

A 4-H Clubs are youth working in groups with a volunteer leader. All 4-H members must belong to a club. Any youth may enroll in any club that is accepting members. Finding a club that fits your schedule and interests is very important so don't be afraid to talk to club leaders before enrolling in a club. Members may switch clubs or be long to more than one if there is a better fit for them somewhere else.

Enrollment

Each Laramie County 4-H member and volunteer must complete an online enrollment through 4h.zsuite.org. There is a \$10 enrollment fee for all youth members (though some projects have additional fees).

If there is more than one youth in your family, everyone can be enrolled under the same household profile. Enrollment must be completed yearly.

ZSuite Enrollment

1. Go to 4h.zsuite.org and click "Sign Up"
2. Create & Remember your pin
3. To add family members, select "Household Members" -> "+ Household Member". Fill in all required fields including clubs and projects.
4. Submit!
5. Once all fees are paid (\$10 enrollment, shooting sports, etc.), and the 4-H Office approves the enrollment, those new enrollments will be Active!
