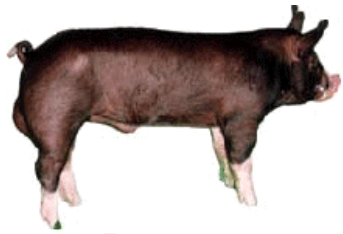

Origin – Berkshire County, England.

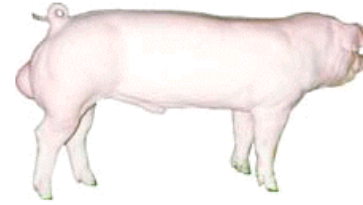
Color – Black with six white points on the feet and legs, tip of the tail, and face.

Ears – Small to medium sized and erect.

Important Traits – Conception rate and meat quality (intramuscular fat)

Origin – Developed in U.S. in Chester County, Pennsylvania

Color – Solid white.

Ears – Small to medium sized and drooping.

Important Traits – Conception rate and mothering ability.

Boar

Origin – Developed in the U.S. from two strains of red hogs: the Jersey Red of New Jersey and the Duroc of New York.

Color – A solid red color ranging from a very light gold to a very dark red.

Ears – Small to medium sized and drooping.

Important Traits – Excellent rate of gain and feed efficiency.

Origin – England.

Color – Black with a white belt encircling the shoulders and front legs.

Ears – Small to medium sized and erect.

Important Traits – Heavily muscled, lean, and good feed efficiency.

Origin – Developed in the U.S. in Iowa and Nebraska.

Color – At least 2/3 red with a white head, ears, underline, feet and tail.

Ears – Medium sized and drooping.

Important Traits – Carcass quality (intramuscular fat).



Boar

Origin – The American Landrace are descendants of the Danish Landrace.

Color – Solid white.

Ears – Very large, heavy, and drooping.

Important Traits – Prolificacy (litter size), milking ability, and mothering ability.

Origin – Pietrain, Belgium.

Color – White with light black spots.

Ears – Medium sized and erect.

Important Traits – Extreme muscling and leanness.

Origin – Developed in U.S. in Butler and Warren Counties of Ohio.

Color – Black with six white points on the feet and legs, tip of the tail, and face.

Ears – Medium sized and drooping.

Important Traits – Meat quality (intramuscular fat).

Ears – Medium sized and drooping.

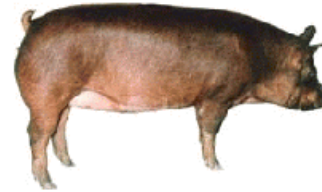

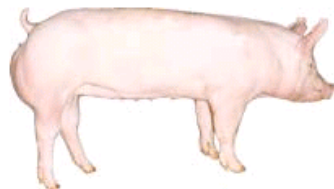

Important Traits – Prolificacy (litter size), milking ability, and mothering ability.



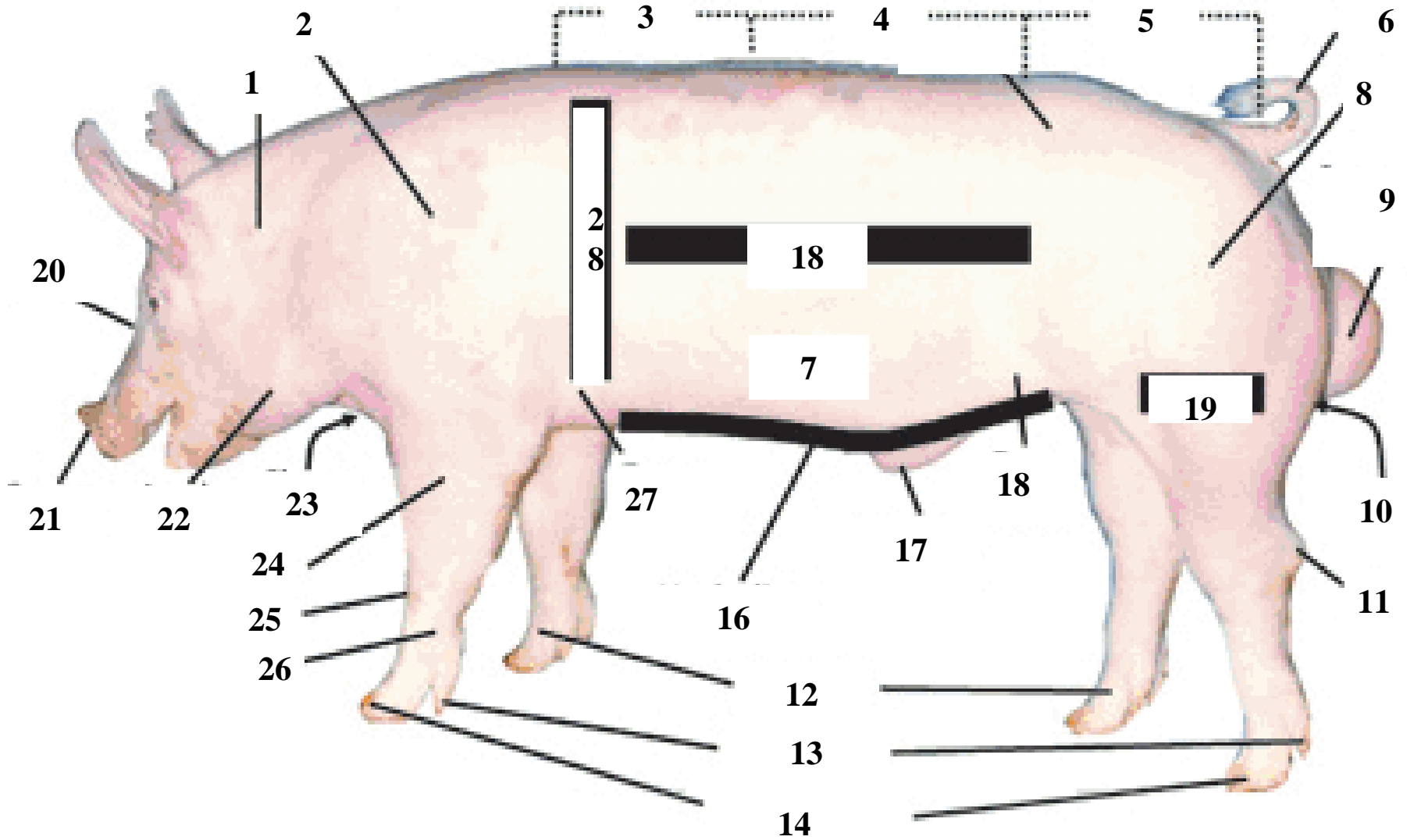

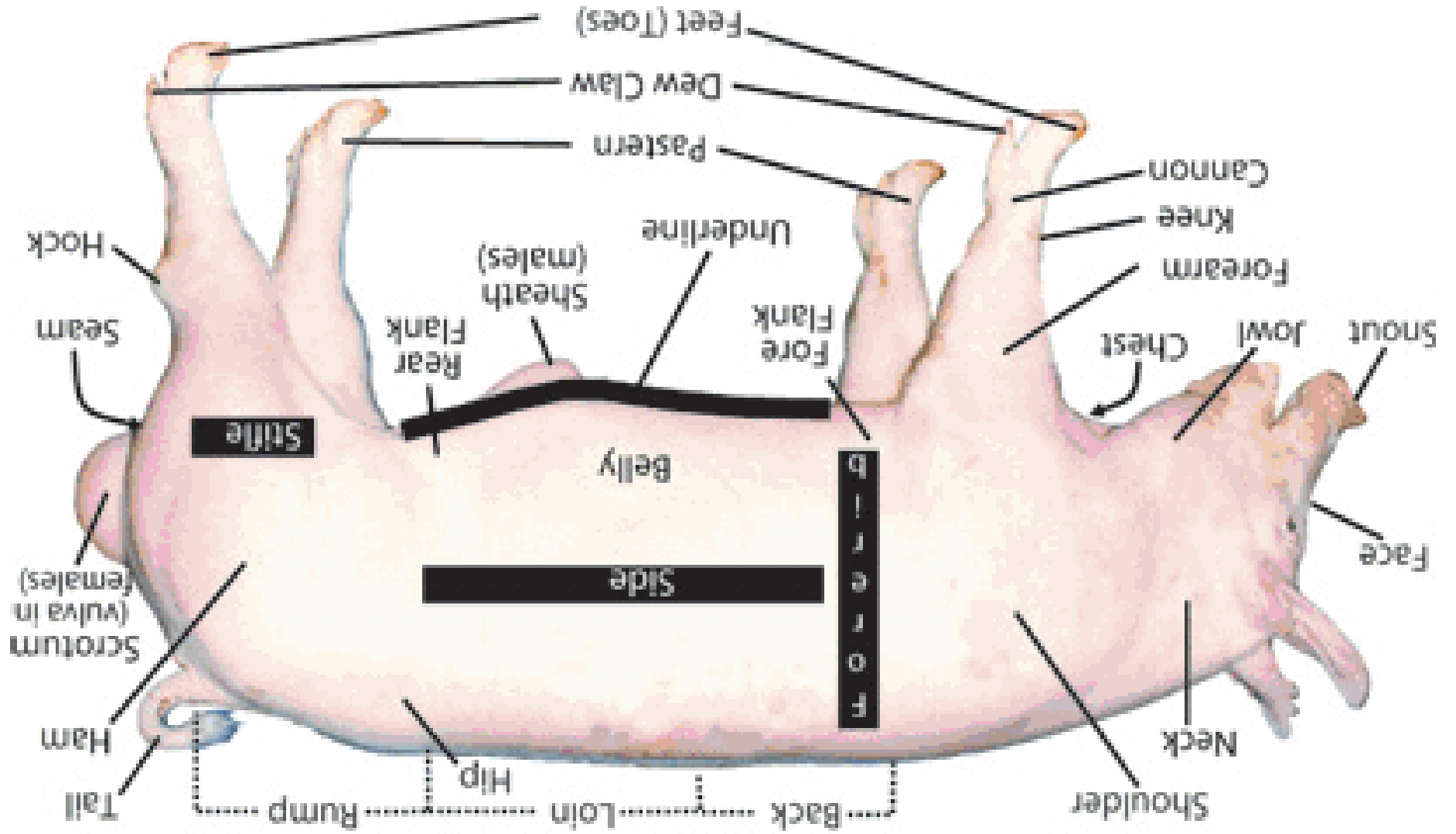

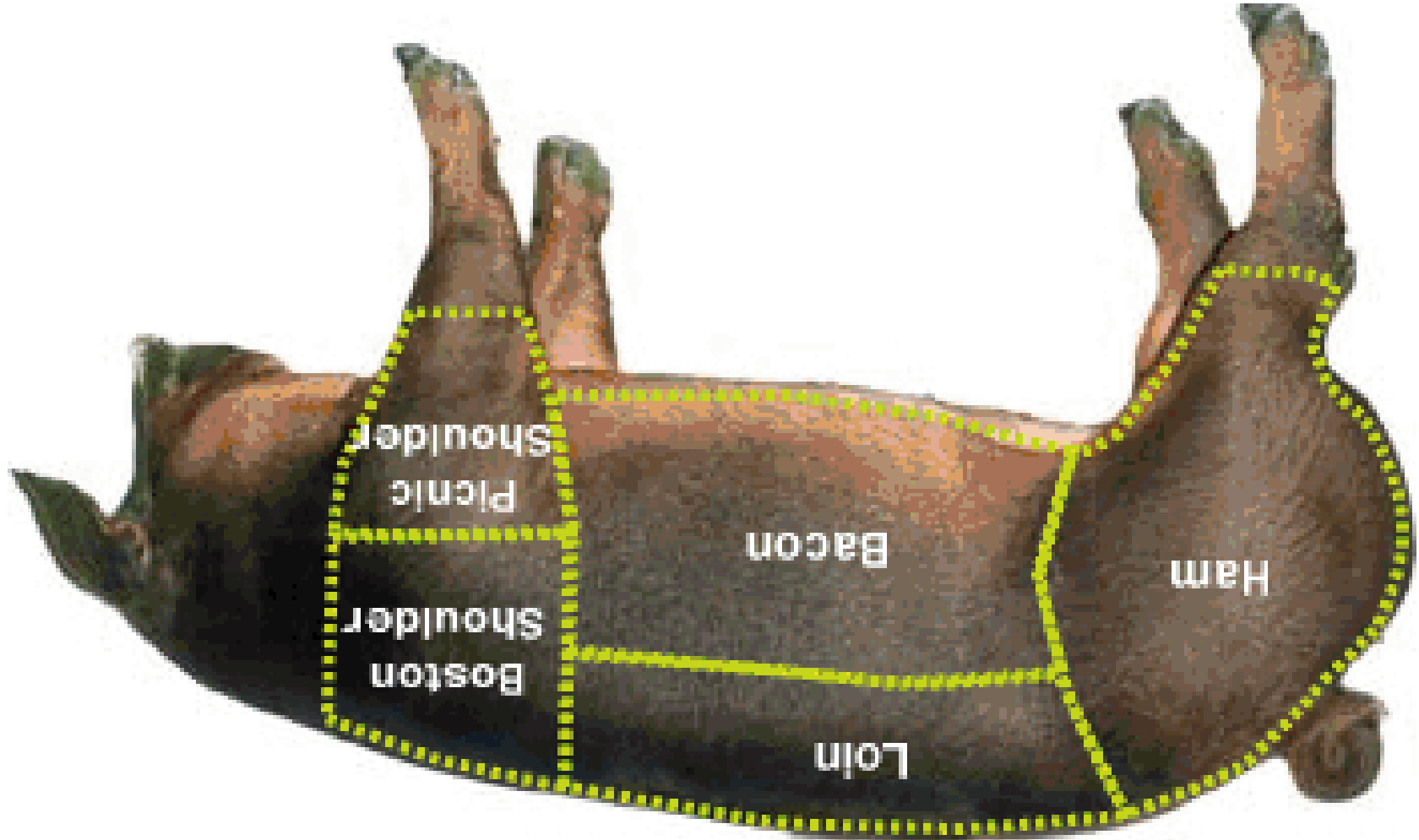
