4-H ENROLLMENT

Again this year we will be doing 4-H enrollment online. Starting October 1st you will have to log into 4h.zsuite.org and create a profile (this is the same place you completed your 4-H Record Books). You will use the same username and password you created your 4-H Record Books. First three people (leaders or members) to sign up starting October 1st will receive a special gift and a FREE enrollment fee.

Sign up for 4-H in the month of October and get half off your 4-H enrollment fee. Half off makes your enrollment \$5/youth.

4-H RECORD BOOKS DUE

Don't forget your record books are due by September 15th to the Extension Office.

NEW 4-H Record Book format this year! The same information goes in the book, just login a little different to access information. Only the new version of record books will be accepted this year – you may find those record books at: wyoming4h.org/washakie4h/record-portfolio/ or stop by the Extension Office and pick up paper copies. Please note there is some helpful tips for completing record books available on the above link.

To earn points towards the Wyoming Honors Club, you **MUST** complete a record book. Record books that are **NOT** judged are **NOT** eligible for awards. Keep in mind record books are an excellent tool for completing college scholarships, do your best work, it is worth the effort, I promise! When your record books are completed and turned in, you may receive your premium money from county fair, (available after September 16)! Also remember, if you are selling livestock and your record book (for each species you sold) is not turned in you are ineligible to sell at next year's junior livestock sale.
