Learning in 4-H is project based. Wyoming 4-H offers over **40** different project areas for learning.



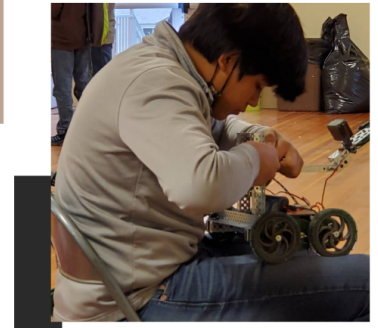

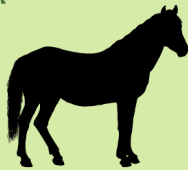

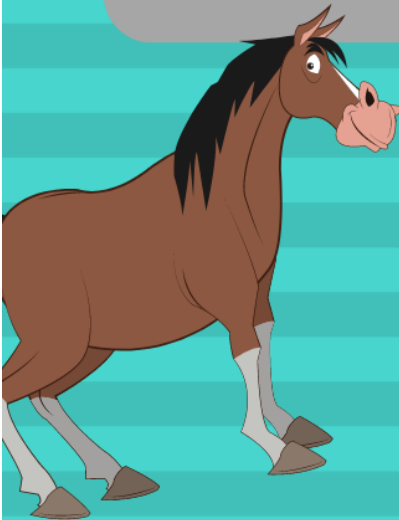
