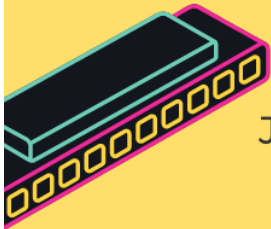

4-H RECORD BOOKS

It is never too early to start record books! Record Books will be done through zSuites. 4-H families can create an account and track all their kids' 4-H record books online, real-time, and saved. You are able to easily add, track, delete, copy, paste, and, even PRINT them out whenever you want without losing data, saving files to your computer or worrying about where they are in the future.

LIVESTOCK QUALITY ASSURANCE

Livestock Quality Assurance is mandatory for all 4-H and FFA members planning to sell animals (to include, beef, sheep, swine, poultry, goats and rabbits) at the Junior Livestock Sale during county fair. This is a requirement each year. Members must either attend a training or they have the option to test out. The test must be passed with an 80% or higher. If members do not pass the test, they must attend a training that year. Deadline to participate is June 30. Parents are highly encouraged to attend! Each year you will move up a level, so if you took level 1 last year you will need to take level 2 this year. If this is your first year as a livestock member you will need to take level 1 (the extension office will send an email to you individually letting you what level you are at). We will try and take advantage of no school days as much as possible.

- o Level 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 – TBA
- o Online – you can take an online test – cost \$10 to complete – contact the Extension Office for the link
- o Test – a written test is available to complete – contact the Extension Office to schedule a test time if interested in this option
