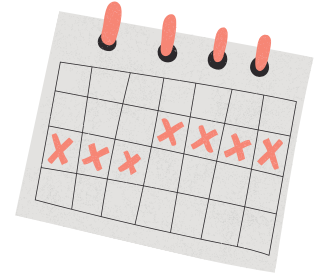

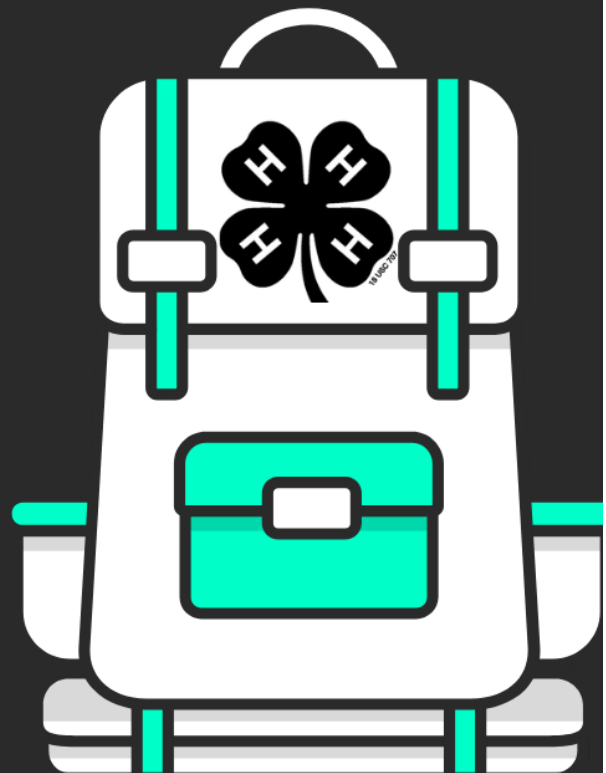

Communication is the key to success in a 4-H program. Key leaders from around the state will share communication techniques that work well for them and how you too can use them to communicate to your club and project members.

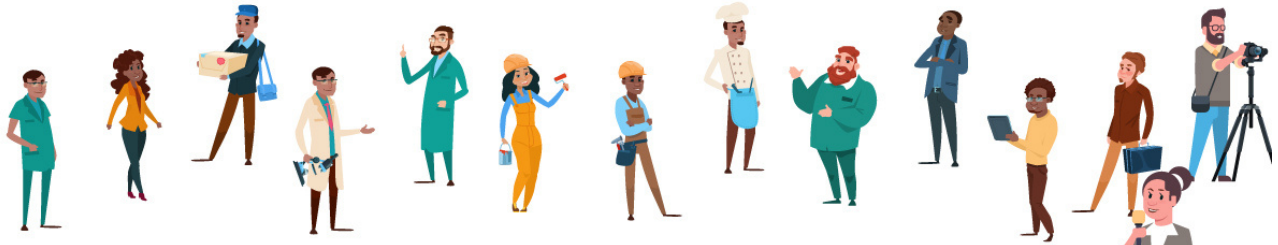

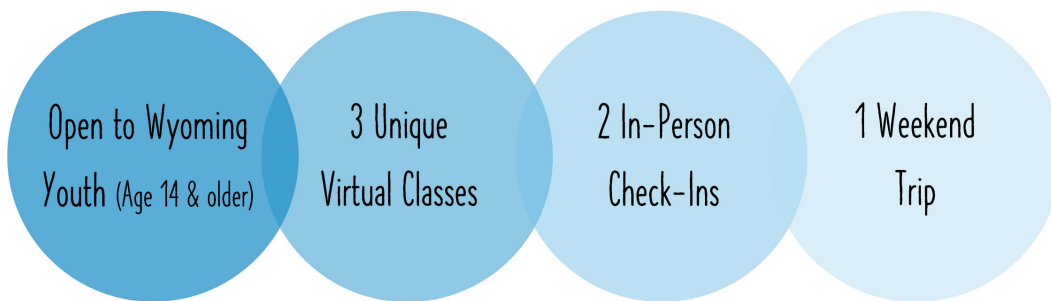
### WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE AN ENTREPRENEUR?

An entrepreneur is someone who organizes, manages and assumes the risks of a business or enterprise.



### WHAT WILL I LEARN DURING THE SERIES?

- Phase One of the Rocky Mountain Youth Entrepreneur Series will assist youth in establishing a business plan, creating a management proposal, forming a vision for their business (to include a Mission Statement/Vision Statement) and work with youth to analyze the market.
- Phase Two of the series will include lessons on business competition, marketing, operation and financial plans and business contingency plans. To complete the series, youth will pitch and present their completed Business Plan to a panel of business professionals for feedback and advice.
