Here are the dates and times for this year's Fabric and Fashion, Ready- to-Wear, Buymanship, Knitting, Crocheting, and Quilting 4-H projects. This year, everything will be held at the Washakie County Fairgrounds.

- ✓ **Monday July 20, 9AM – 11:30AM - Interview Judging and Model-Fairgrounds** We will do all the modeling first then start the interview judging, beginning with the knitting, crocheting and quilting, the Juniors, Intermediates, and the Seniors, finishing close to noon.
- ✓ **Monday July 20, 7PM - Public Style Revue-Fairgrounds**

The guidelines for the script are attached and if possible, it would be nice to include something in the script that reflects this year's theme "See EWE at the Washakie County Fair". Please write a script for each item you will be modeling, at both during the modeling judging and at that evening's Public Style Revue. People who have knitted or crochet items or made a quilt are strongly encouraged to model those items as well. By doing so you will be promoting that part of 4-H that many people are unaware exists.
